A panel of three judges will conduct a final taste test at our luncheon Thursday August 5th. preliminary taste test on coded water samples to select the top five entries for judging will be conducted by the membership.

The Grand Prize Winner will be eligible to enter their water in the National Taste Test sponsored each year by the National Rural Water Association during the Rural Water Rally in Washington, DC.

TASTE TEST RULES

- **Bring one quart of "cooled" water to the conference registration desk by 12 noon Tuesday, August 4th noon. We will also be collecting on Monday August 2nd between 12:00 – 2:00pm. Conference starts Tuesday**
- **A pre-registration form will be coded to identify your system's water**
- **Systems with populations over 25,000 are not eligible**
